#### WHEN TO USE THE MATERIAL

During the week after the family has celebrated the Mass of 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time.

#### OPENING PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we have gathered here in the name of Jesus. May I be mindful of those who are poor, the sick and suffering and always do my best to reach out to them with love and compassion. Holy Spirit, guide us during this lesson. We make this prayer in Jesus' name, Amen.



# SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Invite someone to read from Mark 1: 29-39 followed by the information below. Later, reflect on the questions given together as a family, and share your responses with one another. If necessary, parents are encouraged to rephrase the information and questions according to their children's level of understanding).

### Some thoughts on today's scripture

- Many aspects of the life of Jesus come together in this reading. Jesus goes to the home of Simon and Andrew. The laws of the Sabbath observance required that they have a quiet day. But Simon's mother-in-law was ill and Jesus was moved to cure her. He always put compassion before the law.
- The Sabbath ended at sundown and this allowed "the whole city" to come with their sick and those possessed by the devil. They encamped at the door until Jesus had exercised his healing power. How late was it when all that was over? Yet in the morning, "while it was still very dark", Jesus slipped out of the house, found a deserted place, and gave himself to prayer.
- A search party was sent to look for Jesus. When they found him a conversation takes place between the disciples and Jesus which involved an apostolic choice: to return to Capernaum as the inhabitants wanted, or to move on to other towns? Jesus had already (in prayer?) decided on the latter option.
- 1. Although it was the Sabbath day, and the laws required Jesus and his disciples not to do any "work", Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law. How do you think it was important for Jesus to heal Peter's mother-in-law although the Sabbath law did not allow it?
- 2. Although Jesus has spent the whole night attending to the sick and those possessed by the devil, yet he got up early and spent time in prayer. Why was it important for Jesus pray at the start of the day? What excuses could he have given for not praying so early in the morning?
- 3. Jesus was very popular among the people. So, they were looking for him all the time. It would be easier for him if he stayed in the same city and healed more people. But Jesus wants to leave and go elsewhere. What would you have advised him to do?

#### Activity #10: "Jesus Heals" Art Craft



### Things needed:

- Paper (2 different colours)
- Crayons or markers
- Glue
- Scissor
- Band-aids (at least 2 per child)

### **Parent Preparation:**

Cut out the paper hearts, one large and one smaller for each child.



#### Instructions:

Have your child write "Jesus Heals" on the smaller heart. Guide him or her in creating a cross on the heart with the band-aids. Next, using the glue, have your child mount the smaller heart onto the larger heart. You can encourage your child to jot down or draw pictures of things they believe Jesus can heal.
